<i>Aulopareia ocellata</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Body compressed posteriorly - A pair of short barbels on the chin - Pre-dorsal scales about 25 - Longitudinal scale count 29-31 - Whitish-grey fish, darker on dorsal half of head and body 	D VII 9-I, 10; A I 8; P 19-20
<i>Tenualosa ilisha</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Body fusiform, deep and compressed - Belly with 31-32 scutes - Head length 3.4-3.5 times in standard length - Caudal fin moderate - A dark blotch behind the gill opening, followed by a series of small spots along the flanks 	D iv 14-15; A ii 17-18; P i 14; V i 7
<i>Thryssa stenosoma</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Body compressed and slender, its depth 3.9-4.1 times in standard length - Belly with 27 scutes - Black, brown in colour, fins and belly silvery 	D iii 12; A iii 42-43; P i 12; V i 6
